

Led by Dr. Michele Bowers, the "Read, Lead, Succeed" community-wide literacy program produced impressive gains in its first 100 days - with an average of 10% growth across all literacy domains. Partnered with Footsteps2Brilliance, the program provides bilingual literacy apps free to every family within the Lancaster School District zip codes. Dr. Bowers' 100-Day Entry Plan immediately garnered the adoption of 3,000 families, representing a diverse population, to start using the program so far.
